QUESTION 1: Assets (15 minutes) What do you like most about your community? What would you like to see supported, preserved or enhanced as part of this planning effort? Notes:

- 1. Long history of counter culture, environmental protection important, work as community to take care of community facilities, balance of having a community with environmental stewardship
- 2. Concern about threat to community with zoning change and unintended consequences
- 3. Undeveloped/rural and self-reliant nature of community
- 4. Historic nature going back to Spanish times, pre-statehood
- 5. Strong community where you know and are connected to all your neighbors
- 6. Unique, very cool and eclectic structures/homes/etc.
- 7. Water resources, i.e. upper San Leandro Creek, biological/riparian habitats, ground water resources, should be protected



QUESTION 2: Challenges (15 minutes) What are the challenges facing your community? What would you like to see changed to make it a better place to live and work?
