

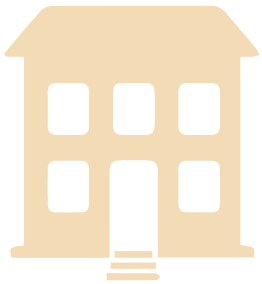

- » **Goal:** Equitable engagement with all communities in the county so that all residents share an equal voice in decisions that affect their community.
- » **Key concepts in the policies and actions:**
 - Prepare public notices in the neighborhoods' predominant languages and provide interpretation at meetings
 - Schedule community meetings at convenient times and locations
 - Partner with local community organizations and leaders on outreach
 - Hold community clean-up days in disadvantaged neighborhoods

Transportation (EJ-F)

- » **Goal:** Equitable, convenient access to a safe, affordable, multi-modal transportation network among all communities in the county so that all residents, regardless of age, ability, race, culture, or economic status, are less dependent on cars and enjoy opportunities to walk, bike, roll, or take transit to their destinations.
